



## The Dutch LIMES Organisation

### National Limes Programme

The Dutch Limes does not have UNESCO heritage status but is protected by the national government. To bring back the heritage to the people, the government has created a common ambition together with municipalities and regional governmental structures along the Limes. The aim is to open up the Limes to a broad audience through cultural and leisure activities, educational programmes, methods for integrating heritage in spatial design, and a communication campaign. The national programme was launched in 2006 and has a strong focus on nationwide cooperation among the stakeholders of the Limes heritage.

### The Dutch LIMES Organisation

The Dutch LIMES Organisation (*Programmabureau de LIMES*) was founded by Dutch national and local authorities to develop and implement a national programme on the Dutch section of the Limes.

Core activities of the Dutch LIMES Organisation are marketing and communication of the Limes heritage in the Netherlands, participation and consultancy on local projects, and operation as a centre of expertise for general and professional audiences.

The Dutch LIMES Organisation distributes several publications on the Dutch Limes and organises seminars and scientific symposia.
